1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Montgomery County – Alcoholic Beverages – Licenses Held by Revenue**  
3 **Authority for Public Golf Courses**

4 **MC 807-08**

5 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Director of the Montgomery County Revenue  
6 Authority or the Director’s designee to hold certain alcoholic beverages licenses  
7 for the limited use of public golf courses that are under the jurisdiction of the  
8 Revenue Authority; repealing the authority of the Director or Deputy Director of  
9 the Montgomery County Parks Department of the Maryland–National Capital  
10 Park and Planning Commission to hold certain licenses; specifying that certain  
11 licenses be signed by the Director of the Revenue Authority or the Director’s  
12 designee; requiring the Director of the Revenue Authority or the Director’s  
13 designee to designate individuals to complete certain training; making a  
14 stylistic change; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages licenses in  
15 Montgomery County.

21 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
22 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

23 **Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages**

24 9–102.2.

25 (a) (1) The Director [or Deputy Director of the Montgomery County Parks  
26 Department of the Maryland–National Capital Park and Planning Commission] **OF**  
27 **THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY REVENUE AUTHORITY OR THE DIRECTOR’S**  
28 **DESIGNEE** may hold more than [1] **ONE** of the following alcoholic beverages licenses  
29 for the limited use of public golf courses that are under the [Commission’s] jurisdiction  
30 [in Montgomery County] **OF THE REVENUE AUTHORITY:**

31 [(1)](I) A Class H beer (on–sale) license; or

32 [(2)](II) A Class H beer and light wine (on–sale) license.

33 (2) **A LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE**  
34 **SIGNED BY THE DIRECTOR OR THE DIRECTOR’S DESIGNEE.**

35 (b) (1) As a condition to holding any license under this section, the  
36 Director [or Deputy Director] **OF THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY REVENUE**  
37 **AUTHORITY OR THE DIRECTOR’S DESIGNEE** shall designate an individual with  
38 respect to each golf course to complete training in an alcohol awareness program  
39 approved under § 13–101 of this article.

40 (2) The individual designated by the Director [or Deputy Director] **OR**  
41 **THE DIRECTOR’S DESIGNEE** shall:

42 (i) Represent the concessionaire; and

43 (ii) Be involved with the management of the sale of beer or light  
44 wine by the concessionaire at the golf course.

45 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
46 July 1, 2008.
