A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Prince George’s County – Maryland–National Capital Park and Planning**
3 **Commission – Community Center Homework Rooms**

4 **PG/MC 113–08**

5 FOR the purpose of requiring that Maryland–National Capital Park and Planning
6 Commission community centers in Prince George’s County set up certain
7 homework rooms; requiring certain personnel to ask students certain questions;
8 requiring certain community centers to keep certain records of certain
9 homework assignments; requiring certain personnel to direct certain students
10 to homework rooms under certain circumstances; defining certain terms; and
11 generally relating to Maryland–National Capital Park and Planning
12 Commission community center homework rooms.

13 BY adding to

14 Article 28 – Maryland–National Capital Park and Planning Commission
15 Section 5–501 to be under the new subtitle “Subtitle 5. Community Center
16 Homework Rooms”

19 Preamble

20 WHEREAS, A compilation of reports entitled “A New Wave of Evidence: The
21 Impact of School, Family, and Community Connections on Student Achievement” is a
22 synthesis of 51 studies about the impact of family and community involvement on
23 student achievement and effective strategies to connect schools, families, and
24 community; and

25 WHEREAS, A review of the research finds growing evidence that family and
26 community connections with schools make a difference in student success; and

27 WHEREAS, The synthesis of the research revealed that academic success is
28 more likely when students spend 8 to 15 hours a week fully engaged in out-of-school
29 learning activities; and

30 WHEREAS, Completion of homework assignments can be one way to help
31 provide 8 to 15 hours a week of out-of-school learning and improve academic success;
32 now, therefore,

33 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
34 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

35 **Article 28 – Maryland–National Capital Park and Planning Commission**

36 **SUBTITLE 5. COMMUNITY CENTER HOMEWORK ROOMS.**

37 **5–501.**

38 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE
39 MEANINGS INDICATED.

40 (2) “COMMUNITY CENTER” MEANS A COMMUNITY CENTER
41 OPERATED UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF THE COMMISSION.

42 (3) “STUDENT” MEANS ANY INDIVIDUAL AT LEAST 5 YEARS OLD
43 BUT UNDER THE AGE OF 16 YEARS.

44 (B) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN PRINCE GEORGE’S COUNTY.

45 **(C) ON MONDAYS, TUESDAYS, WEDNESDAYS, AND THURSDAYS OF THE**
46 **ACADEMIC SCHOOL YEAR FOR THE PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY PUBLIC**
47 **SCHOOLS, A COMMUNITY CENTER SHALL:**

48 **(1) PROVIDE STUDENTS WITH A SUPERVISED ROOM OR AREA**
49 **WHERE HOMEWORK MAY BE COMPLETED; AND**

50 **(2) REQUIRE THE COMMUNITY CENTER DESK PERSONNEL TO ASK**
51 **ENTERING STUDENTS WHETHER THEY HAVE COMPLETED THEIR HOMEWORK**
52 **FOR THAT DAY.**

53 **(D) EACH COMMUNITY CENTER SHALL MAINTAIN WRITTEN OR**
54 **ELECTRONIC RECORDS OF ALL HOMEWORK ASSIGNMENTS FOR EACH PRINCE**
55 **GEORGE'S COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOL THAT IS LOCATED WITHIN A 2 MILE RADIUS**
56 **OF THE COMMUNITY CENTER.**

57 **(E) IF A COMMUNITY CENTER DOES NOT HAVE ACCURATE HOMEWORK**
58 **ASSIGNMENT RECORDS FOR A STUDENT, THE COMMUNITY CENTER DESK**
59 **PERSONNEL SHALL REFER TO THE STUDENT'S HOMEWORK LOG.**

60 **(F) THE COMMUNITY CENTER DESK PERSONNEL SHALL DIRECT**
61 **STUDENTS WHO HAVE NOT COMPLETED THEIR DAILY HOMEWORK ASSIGNMENTS**
62 **TO THE HOMEWORK ROOM.**

63 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
64 October 1, 2008.
