AMENDMENT TO MC 22-17

(Sprint Copy)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 5, strike “altering, in Montgomery County, the” and substitute “authorizing Montgomery County to enact a local law that sets a certain”; strike beginning with “exempting” in line 7 down through “Act;” in line 9, inclusive; in line 14, strike “and 21-803(a)”; and after line 16, insert:

“BY adding to

Article - Transportation
Section 21-801.1(g)
Annotated Code of Maryland
(2012 Replacement Volume and 2016 Supplement)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, strike in their entirety the line 8 through line 21, inclusive and substitute:

“(b) Except as otherwise provided in this section, the maximum speed limits are:

- (1) 15 miles an hour in alleys in Baltimore County;
- (2) 30 miles an hour on:
 - (i) All highways in a business district; and
 - (ii) Undivided highways in a residential district;
- (3) 35 miles an hour on divided highways in a residential district;
- (4) 50 miles an hour on undivided highways in other locations; and
- (5) 55 miles an hour on divided highways in other locations.

(G) IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY, THE COUNTY MAY ENACT A LOCAL LAW THAT SETS THE MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT AT 25 MILES AN HOUR ON:

(1) ALL HIGHWAYS IN A BUSINESS DISTRICT; AND

(2) UNDIVIDED HIGHWAYS IN A RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT.”

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On pages 2 and 3, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 22 on page 2 through line 17 on page 3, inclusive.
