FOR the purpose of prohibiting the name of a candidate for nomination by a principal political party for the office of Montgomery County Executive or member of the Montgomery County Council from being placed on the primary election ballot unless the candidate files a certain petition with the local board of elections; requiring certain petitions to be signed by a certain number of registered voters in certain geographic areas; providing that a petition is subject to certain provisions of law; requiring that a certain petition accompany the certificate of candidacy under certain circumstances and be filed by the deadline for filing a certificate of candidacy; providing that the name of an individual who files a certificate of candidacy and does not withdraw is not required to appear on the primary election ballot if the individual is required to file a certain petition and the petition is not certified in accordance with certain provisions of law; and generally relating to the filing of petitions by County Executive and County Council candidates in Montgomery County.
