5 FOR the purpose of correcting certain references to the Office of the Inspector General in
6 statutes of the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission; providing that certain
7 rights granted to certain Commission merit system employees are not provided to
8 employees in the Office; providing that the Office shall review and approve certain
9 costs for certain facilities designed and constructed by certain developers; and
10 generally relating to the Office of the Inspector General in the Washington Suburban
11 Sanitary Commission.

3 (a) (2) The rights granted to Commission merit system employees under this
4 subtitle do not apply to:

- 5 (i) attorneys in the Office of the General Counsel;
- 6 (ii) confidential employees;
- 7 (iii) probationary employees;
- 8 (iv) employees in the Office of the General Manager;
- 9 (v) employees in the [Internal Audit] Office **OF THE INSPECTOR**
10 **GENERAL**;
- 11 (vi) employees in the Office of the Secretary; or
- 12 (vii) supervisors, as defined in § 2(11) of the National Labor Relations
13 Act, 29 U.S.C. § 152(11).

15 (d) The [Commission’s internal auditor] **OFFICE OF THE INSPECTOR**
16 **GENERAL** shall review and approve the costs incurred by the developer.

17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
18 1, 2019.
