- 2 (d) (1) In this subsection, "Deer Management Permit" means a permit issued 3 by the Department authorizing the holder or an agent of the holder to hunt deer outside of 4 deer hunting season for the purpose of preventing damage to crops.
- 5 (2) In Charles County, Calvert County, St. Mary's County, and Harford County, an individual who hunts deer under a Deer Management Permit may:
- 7 (i) Use a shotgun or breech loading center fired rifle approved by 8 the Department to hunt deer throughout the year, including all deer hunting seasons, in 9 the locations and under the conditions set forth in the permit; and
- 10 (ii) On State land in Charles County, Calvert County, St. Mary's County, or Harford County leased by the permit holder for the purpose of cultivating crops, hunt deer on the leased land in the locations and under the conditions set forth in the permit.
- 14 (3) To protect public safety and welfare, the Department may restrict the lands on which an individual may hunt deer under a Deer Management Permit.
- 16 (4) (i) This paragraph applies only in Frederick County.
- 17 (ii) Subject to the conditions set forth in a Deer Management Permit, 18 a permittee may use a rifle approved by the Department to harvest deer throughout the 19 year, including all deer hunting seasons.
- 20 (iii) In Frederick County Zone 1, as defined in COMAR 21 08.03.03.06A.(3)(g), an agent of a permittee may use a rifle to harvest deer throughout the 22 year.
- 23 (iv) 1. This subparagraph applies only in Frederick County Zone 24 2, as defined in COMAR 08.03.03.06A.(3)(h).
- 25 2. Except as provided in subsubparagraph 3 of this subparagraph, an agent of a permittee may use a rifle to harvest deer in a period beginning October 1 and ending March 31.

- 7 (II) SUBJECT TO THE CONDITIONS SET FORTH IN A DEER 8 MANAGEMENT PERMIT, A PERMITTEE MAY USE A RIFLE APPROVED BY THE 9 DEPARTMENT TO HARVEST DEER THROUGHOUT THE YEAR, INCLUDING ALL DEER 10 HUNTING SEASONS.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 12 October 1, 2020.
